PAWS FOR WCDS

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<u>History</u>

In 2020 PAWS for WCDS, a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization was created with a purpose of supporting the Wayne County Dog Shelter through fundraising efforts. PAWS for WCDS has since created 4 additional play yards with play structures, improved the quality of vaccinations given to the dogs, provided heartworm prevention to all dogs at the shelter, added acoustic paneling to the kennel areas, and begun funding a spay/neuter program so that all dogs will be altered prior to adoption.

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Mission

PAWS for WCDS is a 501(c)(3) non-profit, charitable organization whose core mission is to provide support to The Wayne County Dog Shelter & Adoption Center. Our mission is to accomplish this through volunteerism, fundraising efforts and educational training opportunities, along with raising awareness of the necessities needed for the shelter and shelter dogs. We are an all-volunteer organization who have a passion, and desire to assist the shelter in providing above standard care and compassion to each dog who arrives at the shelter.

Vision

PAWS for WCDS vision is to support, promote and enhance the services provided by the Wayne County Dog Shelter & Adoption Center. PAWS for WCDS assists in providing the highest level of care physically, emotionally and mentally to the shelter dogs, in addition to working to fund a spay and neuter initiative to reduce the dog over population.

HISTORY

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The Wayne County Dog Shelter opened in September 2015. The shelter is a county operated dog shelter that is responsible for caring for the stray dogs in Wayne County, Ohio. Our shelter is funded primarily on the sale of dog licenses and donations. We work very hard to reunite dogs with their owners, we provide adoption services, and we offer educational programs on canine care and safety to the community.

In January 2019 the Wayne County Board of Commissioners appointed shelter Director Katelyn Lehman, as the Dog Warden for Wayne County. Dog Warden services are now provided through the Wayne County Dog Shelter. These services include the enforcement of dog licenses laws, impounding dogs running at large, and investigating dog bites and deeming dog's nuisance, dangerous or vicious.

<u>MISSION</u>

The mission of the Wayne County Dog Shelter is to provide temporary shelter, care, and comfort to all stray, abandoned, neglected, and injured dogs in Wayne County; to reunite lost dogs with their owners; and to promote a humane and responsible community in Wayne County through education and outreach.

VISION

The Vision of the Wayne County Dog Shelter is to reduce the stray dog population through the education and enforcement of dog laws. We hope to keep Wayne County dogs safe by educating owners on the importance of licensing their dogs and keeping their dogs properly confined according to the Ohio Law. We are also committed to reducing the overpopulation of animals through the promotion of spay and neuter. Specific shelter goals are to return as many dogs as possible to their owners, spay and neuter each dog prior to adoption, and maintain a minimum of 90% placement rate each year. A successful placement rate would include dogs that have been adopted, rescued or owner claimed. We will accomplish these goals through the promotion of dog licensing, microchipping, fundraising, and marketing.



WAYNE COUNTY DOG SHELTER:

CARING FOR STRAYS, ONE PAW AT A TIME

At Wayne County Dog Shelter, every dog matters. As the designated shelter for Wayne County, we have the responsibility - and the privilege- of taking in all the stray dogs from the area. Each day, dogs in need walk through our doors, many of them frightened, malnourished, or injured and it is our job to give them the care they deserve.

The Hidden Costs of Medical Care for Strays

Many dogs arrive at the shelter requiring more than just a safe place to sleep, they need medical attention. Whether it is treating infections, mending broken bones, or addressing long-term health conditions, we ensure that every dog has access to the necessary medical care.

So far in 2024, the shelter has spent **\$50,162.34** on medical expenses in just the first three quarters. That number represents hundreds of dogs that required vaccinations, surgeries, medications and more. For a shelter like Wayne County, where every dollar counts, it is a staggering sum.

Spaying and Neutering: Building a Sustainable Future

Along with medical care, one of the most important responsibilities is to ensure that every dog is altered before leaving for its forever home.

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Spaying and neutering helps prevent unwanted litters, reduces overpopulation, and improves the overall health and behavior of the dogs.

We are committed to building a sustainable spay and neuter program with our partner organization, **PAWS for WCDS.** Together, we share the ultimate goal of ensuring that every dog is altered before adoption, helping to create a healthier future for our furry friends. In the first three quarters of 2024, we've spent an additional \$11,399.66 from our spay and neuter fund to make this dream a reality.

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We Can't Do It Alone - We Need Your Help!

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




